KC STREETCAR SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

(Kansas City, Missouri) – KC Streetcar service will be suspended on Wednesday, February 5, for the Chiefs Kingdom Champions Parade.

Kansas City will host the Chiefs Kingdom Champions Parade for the Super Bowl Champions, the Kansas City Chiefs, on Wednesday, February 5, at 11:30 a.m. The parade will be followed by a victory rally at Union Station. As a result of anticipated record crowds downtown, safety and operational considerations, and parade logistics at Union Station, there will be no KC Streetcar service on Wednesday, February 5.

KC Streetcar service will conclude as scheduled Tuesday evening, February 4, and not resume until safe to do so after the parade on Wednesday.
