

PROJECT OVERVIEWS



The KC Streetcar Riverfront Extension is taking the Downtown starter-line north on the existing Grand Boulevard Bridge to Kansas City's Riverfront.

The 0.7-mile extension begins at 3rd Street and Grand Boulevard in the River Market and ends near the midpoint of Berkley Riverfront—about a 5-minute walk to the future KC Current stadium.



The Grand Boulevard Bike/Pedestrian Bridge

is adding a new bridge with dedicated lanes for both bicyclists and pedestrians to separate them from vehicular traffic.

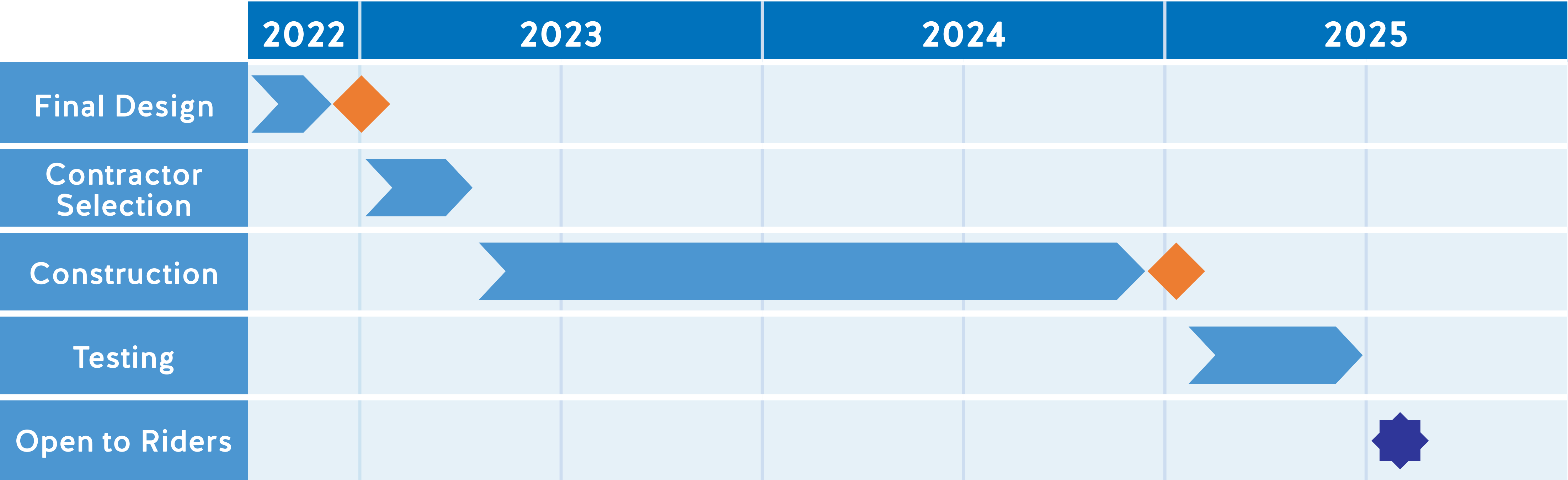
The new bridge will extend from 2nd Street and Grand Boulevard and run parallel to the existing Grand Boulevard bridge.

Both projects will provide easy, multimodal access to and from Downtown and make both districts even more accessible and attractive to live, work, and play.

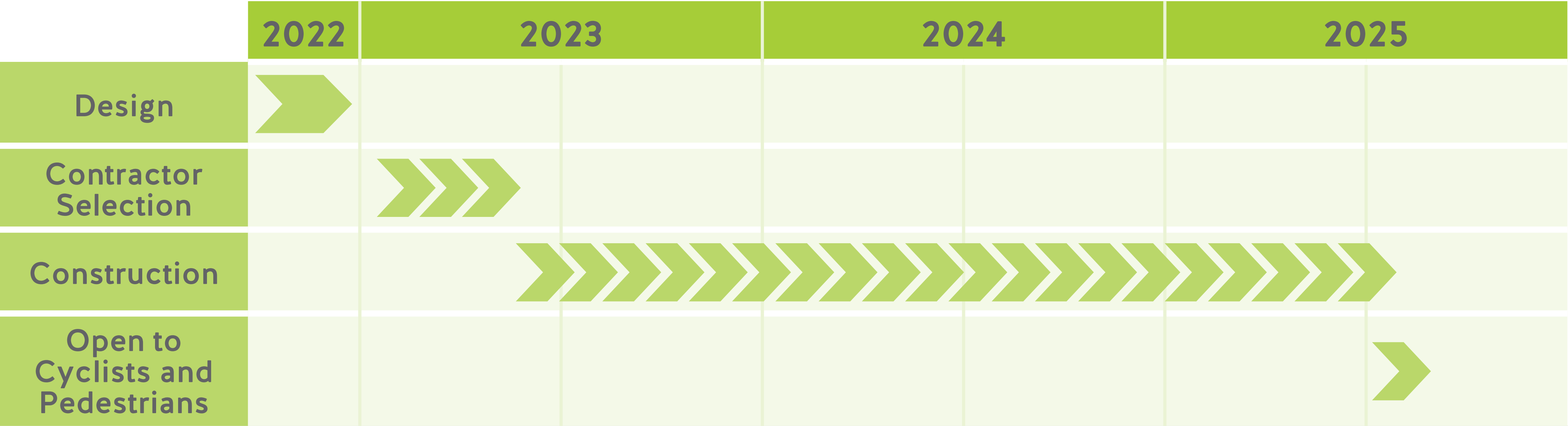


PROJECT TIMELINES

Both the KC Streetcar Riverfront Extension and Grand Boulevard Bike/Pedestrian Bridge are scheduled to be open to the public in 2025.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction of both projects is anticipated to begin in 2023.

Closure of the Grand Boulevard Bridge will be required for 6 to 12 months so the bridge can be prepared to install rail tracks.

The project team is working to minimize inconvenience during construction and will continue to evaluate creative solutions to provide access and minimize full closure time.

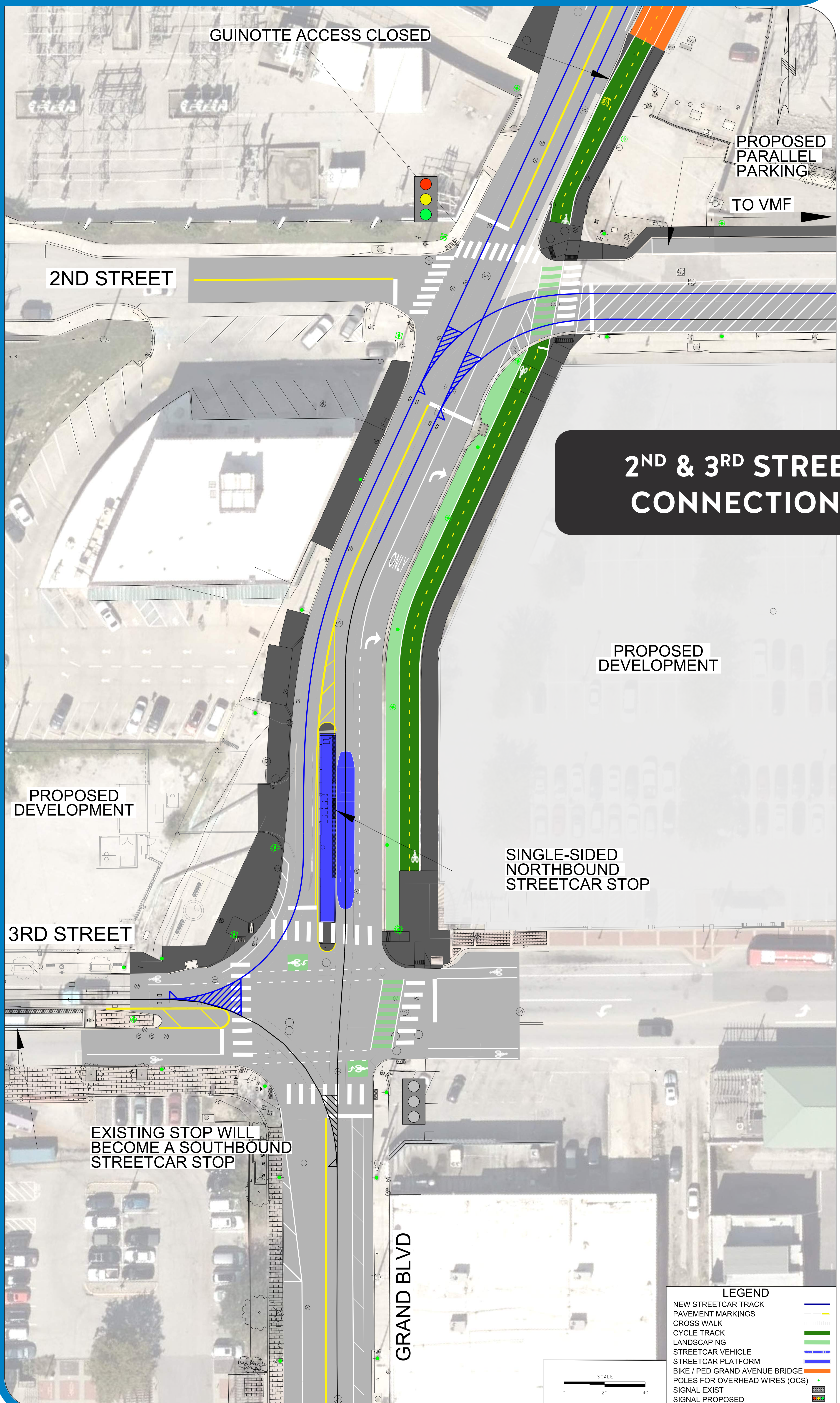

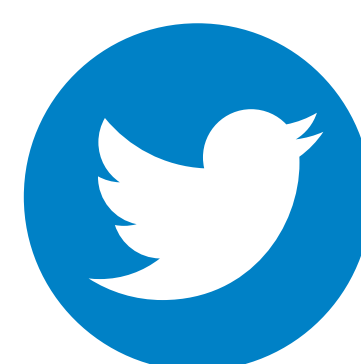
